

Protect your right to Keep and Bear Arms!

You do *not* currently have that right!

“If Plaintiffs (gun owners) are implying that a right to keep and bear arms is one of the rights recognized in the California Constitution’s declaration of rights THEY ARE SIMPLY WRONG. No mention is made in it of a right to keep and bear arms. “ (Kasler v. Lockyer 2000) - California Supreme Court

“Because the Second Amendment affords only a collective right to own or possess guns or other firearms, the district court's dismissal of plaintiffs; [gun owners'] Second Amendment claims is AFFIRMED.“ (Silveira v. Lockyer 2002) - Ninth Circuit Court of Appeals

How do we fix this?

By amending the California Constitution to add an explicit, individual right *and* by protecting that right from activist courts and rogue lawmakers. Until the Supreme Court of the Unites States holds that the Second Amendment is an individual right protected under the Fourteenth Amendment, states are free to restrict or eliminate our rights unless bound by their own Constitutions.

How can I help?

By volunteering to help qualify this initiative for the November 2006 ballot. Simply making sure that gun stores and clubs, shooting ranges and groups, and other rights-loving groups in your area are aware of this initiative, that they have a supply of petition forms, and that completed forms are submitted properly will not take a lot of your time, but could make an enormous difference in collecting enough signatures!
